

About PolyU SPEED Bachelor's Degree Programmes

The degree programmes described in this brochure are top-up Bachelor's Degree programmes specially designed for holders of Associate Degree / Higher Diploma for further studies toward undergraduate degree level. Students are required to complete 45 credits of study. The normal duration for completing a programme is 1.5 years for full-time study or 3 years for part-time study. English is the medium of instruction, unless otherwise specified.

All programmes will commence on 1 September 2009.

Recognition and Articulation

All PolyU SPEED Bachelor's Degree programmes are accredited and approved by The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. The PolyU SPEED qualification gives graduates an excellent opportunity to progress to a higher level of study. At present, many institutions, both local and overseas, recognise our graduates as having met the entrance requirements of their Master's degree programmes.

Apart from academic recognition, some PolyU SPEED programmes have also obtained recognition from relevant professional bodies.

State-of-the-art Campus Facilities

Most of the classes of PolyU SPEED top-up degree programmes will be held at PolyU extended campuses. Classes of part-time programmes will normally be conducted at the Hung Hom Bay Campus while those of full-time programmes will normally be conducted at the Hung Hom Bay Campus / West Kowloon Campus.*

Both Hung Hom Bay Campus and West Kowloon Campus are equipped with state-of-the-art teaching and learning facilities that offer a vigorous environment for all-round student development. All students enrolled on programmes leading to PolyU SPEED awards are entitled to library, computing and sports facilities at both extended campuses.

* For Bachelor of Arts in Applied and Media Arts, most of the classes will be held at the premises of the Hong Kong Art School (the collaborating institution of the programme), while some classes will be delivered at PolyU extended campuses.



Scholarships

- International Summer School Scholarship

SPEED provides scholarships for well performed students to pursue study in selected overseas universities during summer holidays.

- Cultural Exchange Scholarship for Chinese Mainland

This scholarship scheme provides opportunities for students to work as interns in the Chinese mainland during summer holidays.

Alumni Association

The SPEED Alumni Association is established under the Federation of PolyU Alumni Associations to promote fellowship among graduates and foster links with alumni of the PolyU community. Graduates of PolyU SPEED award programmes are eligible to join the SPEED Alumni Association.
