

Applied Learning Chinese (for non-Chinese speaking students) (ApL(C)) – Chinese in Business Service

This ApL(C) course is offered by the Department of Chinese and Bilingual Studies (CBS) of PolyU through SPEED for senior secondary non-Chinese speaking students. The course aims to develop non-Chinese speaking students' Chinese language competencies using the second language learning approach with tourism, hotel, logistics and retails industry as the learning context. The course consists of 3 levels of studies which are pegged at the Qualifications Framework (QF) Level 1, 2 and 3. Each level contains three modules, including Oral Communication (Cantonese), Reading and Writing.

Modes of Delivery








Mode 1: Classes take place mainly on the PolyU Hung Hom Bay Campus on Saturdays.

Mode 2: Classes take place mainly in the secondary school concerned. Detailed arrangements will be worked out among the secondary school concerned and SPEED.

Duration

270 contact hours, extending over three school years.
