Introduction

Established in 2001 under the auspices of The Hong Kong Polytechnic University, Hong Kong Community College (HKCC) is a self-financed post-secondary institution which offers more than 30 Associate Degree (AD) and Higher Diploma (HD) programmes for Form 7 graduates as well as a Pre-Associate Degree (Pre-AD) programme for Form 5 graduates.

HKCC is committed to the betterment of our younger generation's future and to the training of quality human resources for our knowledge-based society. To cater for the needs of different students, HKCC's wide spectrum of programmes spans arts, science, social sciences, business and a number of specialised areas.

HKCC runs its AD/HD programmes on two campuses - the PolyU HKCC West Kowloon Campus hosts business programmes while the PolyU HKCC Hung Hom Bay Campus hosts science & technology programmes, communication & social sciences programmes and specialised programmes.

Aims and Objectives

The programmes of HKCC provide students with a holistic post-secondary education for further studies or career development.

Quality Assurance

The AD/HD programmes of HKCC follow the common descriptors of the Education Bureau. They are accredited and approved by the PolyU Senate. Successful completion of HKCC AD/HD programmes will lead to PolyU HKCC awards, while completion of the Pre-AD Programme will lead to a Certificate of Attainment issued by HKCC.

Credit-based System

Programmes offered by HKCC are credit-based. By providing students with greater flexibility in their selection of subjects and pace of study, such a system has the merit of being more responsive to the changing needs of students and society. The system also facilitates credit transfers to other programmes or from other recognised institutions.

Campus Life and Facilities

On the campuses in Hung Hom Bay and West Kowloon, HKCC students can enjoy comprehensive teaching and learning facilities including lecture theatres and classrooms, libraries, computer centres, canteens, multi-purpose halls, language laboratories, design studios, healthcare laboratory, etc. AD/HD students can also use the Pao Yue-kong Library and sports venues on the PolyU main campus.

Student Development Activities

The Student Development Committee of HKCC organises a wide range of co-curricular activities including complementary studies and physical education programmes so as to enhance the all-round development of students, enrich their campus life and provide them with a unique learning experience. Besides, the Committee also hosts activities to assist students in their further studies and career development. The HKCC Students' Union, along with about thirty clubs and societies, also organises a wide array of interesting and learning-enriching activities for fellow students.

Articulation Opportunities

HKCC AD/HD graduates can apply for entrance into local or overseas universities, not the least of which are those



programmes offered by PolyU academic departments and PolyU SPEED. Besides, the College has official articulation agreements with overseas and local universities. HKCC graduates pursuing further studies with these universities may be eligible for credit exemptions. The articulation rate of HKCC AD graduates – averaging at 75.4% from 2003 to 2009 and hitting 82.9% in 2009 – ranks among the highest in Hong Kong. Graduates of the Pre-AD programme, depending on academic performance, can enjoy direct entry into HKCC AD/HD programmes.

Financial Assistance

Students may apply for the Government's Financial Assistance Scheme for Post-secondary Students (FASP) or Non-means Tested Loan Scheme (NLS). They may also apply for Student Travel Subsidy.
